

- Project Directors' role
  - Managing **timeline** for success (recruitment; mentoring; retention; pipelining)
  - Adhering to **scope** of funded project
  - Aligning graduate training of Fellow to TESA funded
  - Mentoring Fellows for success
  - Managing **reporting** (project accomplishments; Fellow's progress; Entry/Exit; Impacts)
- Extensions of grant period
  - No longer than 5 years

## Beneficiary Support

- **M.S. Level:** maximum of twenty-four (24) months during a thirty-month period;
- **Ph.D. Level:** maximum of thirty-six (36) months within a forty-two-month period;
- **IRTA:** eligible USDA NN Fellows with a year remaining on the NNF grant award.

## Recruitment

- **When** – with receipt of the Notice of Award from NIFA
- **Scope** – sign up students committed to TESA
- **Who** – can be outsourced BUT remains the management responsibility of the Project Director
- **What** – materials must identify/acknowledge NIFA NNF grant support

## Recruitment Interval

  - If students have not been appointed by 18 months the monies must be returned to NIFA

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# Financial Reporting

- For any award, the awardees' institution completes financial reporting (SF 269) as required under the Terms and Conditions of the Award.
- The reporting information in the award document is usually submitted by your institutional Grants and Contracts Office.

## What is the responsibility of the PD in financial reporting?

- PDs should follow-up to determine that reporting on their awards is made

### Why is this important?

- Should you submit an application for future funding, untimely reporting can impact subsequent award processing

# How To Acknowledge Grant Support from NIFA

- Along with the USDA logo, the following acknowledgment of NIFA support must appear in the publication of any material, whether copyrighted or not, and any products produced in electronic formats (e.g., World Wide Web pages, computer programs, recruitment flyers, etc.) which is substantially based upon or developed under this award:
  - "This material is based upon [work] supported by the National Institute of Food and Agriculture, U.S. Department of Agriculture, under Agreement No. [the awardees should enter the applicable award number here]."

# Acknowledging NIFA Grant Support . . .

In addition, all publications and other materials, except scientific articles or papers published in scientific journals, must contain the following statement:

- "Any opinions, findings, conclusions, or recommendations expressed in this publication are those of the author(s) and do not necessarily reflect the view of the U.S. Department of Agriculture."
- **The awardee is responsible for assuring that an acknowledgment of [agency] support is made during news media interviews, including popular media such as radio, television and news magazines, that discuss in a substantial way work funded by this grant.**

## Grants

### Federal Regulations for NIFA Awards

Most regulations applicable to National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) awards are housed in Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations. The Code of Federal Regulations is accessible through the [National Archives and Records Administration](#). The following regulations may be of particular interest to NIFA awardees; however, the list is not all inclusive. Note that each regulation does not apply to each and every award. It is important to refer to the request for applications, the award document, or the content of the regulations for its applicability.

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) published two Federal Register Notices on Tuesday, May 11, 2004 (69 FR 26275 and 69 FR 26281). The Notices implement changes affecting the location of policy guidance for grants and other agreements.

In the [first notice](#), OMB established a single title in the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) (i.e., title 2 of the CFR) along with two subtitles (i.e., subtitles A and B). Subtitle A of title 2 is to house OMB's guidance to Federal agencies for grants and agreements. Subtitle B of title 2 will house agency regulations implementing the OMB guidance.

By way of the [second notice](#), OMB relocates the existing OMB Circular A-110 to title 2 in the CFR,
